NATIONAL VIETNAM WAR VETERANS DAY VIETNAM WAR COMMEMORATION

Port Hueneme—The U.S. Navy Seabee Museum will honor and recognize Vietnam Veterans for their service to the Nation and Navy on Thursday, March 29, 2018 at noon. Along with Veterans' attendance, the U.S. Navy Seabee Museum invites regional Sailors to join the event to say "thank-you" in-person to those who came before them. All Vietnam Veterans in attendance will be recognized. Dr. Lara Godbille, Director of the U.S. Navy Seabee Museum will give a lecture on Lessons Learned by Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps in Vietnam. This event is open to the general public. It will be live streamed on the U.S. Navy Seabee Museum Facebook page at the following URL: https://www.facebook.com/seabeemuseum/.

The U.S. Navy performed a wide array of missions during the Vietnam War. The Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act of 2017 designates 29 March, 2018 National Vietnam War Veterans Day. It is an annual event that is part of the 13-year Commemoration of the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War that runs through 2025.

The U.S. Navy Seabee Museum is a historical resource for the Naval Construction Force and U.S. Navy Civil Engineer Corps; it is the place where Seabees and CEC officers may preserve important historical items related to their experience. The U.S. Navy Seabee Museum is free to the public. The U.S. Navy Seabee Museum is located at the Naval Base Ventura County outside the perimeter fence at the corner of Ventura Road and Sunkist, near the Sunkist entrance. The Museum is not on base and you can access the Museum parking lot from Ventura Road. The U.S. Navy Seabee Museum is a federal facility and it is illegal to enter the premises with weapons, explosives, incendiary devices, and illicit drugs.



We are active in the education of our youth in our local schools by speaking at the schools to the students. We support and provide college scholarships every year. We have been the organization responsible for bringing the 'Traveling Wall' Vietnam Memorial to Ventura six times in the last 30 years and are planning on doing so again in 2018. We provide full military honor and color guards in parades and at funerals. We work closely with literally hundreds of other organizations and our elected officials both State and Federal in the county to see veterans' needs are met.

Our group runs around 130 strong, most living in Ventura, but some as far away as Australia and Canada. We are asking for donations to our cause, by selling advertising space in our newsletter.
