Quoting from their own brochure, "Oxnard Family Circle Adult Day Health Care Center program is designed to help adults who require assistance in the maintenance of their health and to either improve or maintain the functional abilities and/or activities of daily living." There are four main categories of service available to eligible seniors and veterans. Part of the eligible process is a referral from a primary care health care professional. 

We have been the organization responsible for bringing the 'Traveling Wall' Vietnam Memorial to Ventura six times in the last 30 years and are planning on doing so again in 2018. We provide full military honor and color guards in parades and at funerals. We work closely with literally hundreds of other organizations and our elected officials both State and Federal in the county to see veterans' needs are met.
