Honoring Tim Tobin, Army, and Vietnam Veteran First, I would like to thank VVVC members Joe Richardson, Debora Ehrich, Bud, and Kay Gray, for attending Tim Tobin's memorial service on August 23 rd.

I first met Tim between 1998 and 2000, my agency assigned me to Litton Agoura, CA as a Contract Specialist, for Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA). Tim was the government liaison for Litton. We often negotiated contract terms and prices for DoD contracts.

After I had learned that Tim was a Vietnam Veteran, I invited him to present his Vietnam experiences at Moorpark High School. Besides Moorpark, Tim and I presented our experiences at Thousand Oaks high, Camarillo High, Chaminade High, Sacred Heart High, Newbury Park High, Newbury Park Academy, Redwood Middle School, and Anacapa Middle School.

Even though Tim never joined the VVVC, Tim presented with me for over twenty-five plus years.

In 2003 when I was raising funds for Ventura County Veteran Memorial Highway Signs, Tim was successful in obtaining a \$5,000 donation from Litton Woodland Hills.

Rest in peace Tim.
